Bailiwick Law Enforcement continues to work closely with the Home Affairs Committee to address the recommendations contained within the HMICFRS report. In addition Bailiwick Law Enforcement are addressing the 'areas for improvement' as identified by HMICFRS.

Head of Law Enforcement Ruari Hardy said: "Since taking up the position as Head of Law Enforcement at the beginning of January, the HMICFRS report recommendations and areas for improvement have been among my priorities. The completion and commissioning of a new facility for victims of crime and addressing issues with regarding governance are just a few of the areas where progress has so far been made, but with a breadth of areas to address there are many work streams still in progress. We continue to liaise and update the Committee for Home Affairs on progress.

"Later this year, HMICFRS are due back to the Island and they will ask to see the progress we are making in response to their report as well as providing the Committee for Home Affairs with an update upon progress."
