Investigation Update – Rohais Motor Centre burglary

Over the weekend we arrested four people in connection with the items stolen from the Rohais Motor Centre burglary a month ago.

The four people – two males and two females, all in their early 20s – have been questioned and released on bail on suspicion of handling stolen goods, after a stop and search of a vehicle found that it was fitted with a Pioneer stereo unit which matched one of those stolen.

Detective Sergeant Ian Tanner said: “Information received from the public assisted us in these arrests, and I want to thank those who contacted us with what they knew. There are still a number of items outstanding and I would urge anyone who knows anything, no matter how small a detail to contact us or Crimestoppers anonymously. There is still a reward for information which leads to a conviction or the recovery of the stolen items. What might seem like a small detail to you could be the exact piece of information we need.”
